Each week we will introduce a new letter of the alphabet. To reinforce the letter sounds, we ask that your child bring in a small object in a paper bag every Tuesday that starts with the sound of the week. The children will give their class clues about the object

they have selected. All of the objects will go into our sound box for the week and be sent home on Friday.

Please do not send any object that are sentimental or expensive. The class will have access to them for the week.



Classroom Rules

The class rules are made to focus on what we can do in the classroom. I try to always focus on the positive behaviors rather than the negative. The children are taught about choices. I explain that everyone is responsible for their own choices, good and bad. We remind students of the class rules daily. Children are reminded and encouraged to communicate their feeling to one another in a positive way. Our class uses a traffic light behavior system that provides children a visual consequence for not making good choices. All of the children begin their day on the green light. If they do not follow the classroom rules their name moves from green to yellow and then red. If a student has their name on red, a phone call will be made to the parent or guardian and an incident report will go on file. I would like to thank you in advance for your support.
