## SPACE COAST CHRISTIAN ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

The Space Coast Christian Sports League was founded in 2000 based on the principles that likeminded schools desired a positive, competitive environment for their students to play sports. The league has grown over the years to include private, parochial, public, and non-denominational schools which share the same virtues and values. All schools agree that the original Christian foundations continue to provide the framework which we all find desirable. As members of the league we all agree:

## General League Rules

- 1. All players, coaches, parents, and fans will present themselves in a positive, courteous manner.
- 2. Disrespect to coaches, players, referees, or fans, is not acceptable.
- 3. Coaches are expected to set a good example for players, participants, and fans to follow.
- 4. Never argue or challenge the referees.
- 5. Profanity is totally unacceptable.
- 6. Respect the rules of the host school.
- 7. Consult your Administrator on Duty at the school hosting the event if you find a situation unacceptable.
- 8. The Administrator on Duty at the hosting school has complete authority and may exit anyone who is violating the rules of the league.

## Safety Rules

- 1. Each school will have an administrator or designated supervisor from their school present at each athletic activity.
- 2. Elementary aged children and children below elementary age are required to be directly supervised by either their parents or a designated adult. This does not include teenage siblings or friends.
- 3. Students are not to be in any area unless under the direct supervision of an adult. This will include restrooms, etc. Playgrounds are off limits at Holy Trinity, Indian Harbour Montessori, Calvary, Odyssey, Community Christian, and Brevard Christian.
- 4. No food, drink, or gum is allowed in any gymnasium.
- 5. Children who are wandering without adult supervision will be taken to the designated adult.
- 6. Any physical altercation will result in the removal of said person for that game or further admission to games at that venue, and possibly a referral to the Police Department.
- 7. The Administrator on Duty hosting the event will have ultimate authority to remove the offender from the venue.
- 8. The offender will no longer be admitted to league functions.
- 9. Ultimately, parents are responsible for the safety of their children.

Every parent/guardian of a child participating in the Space Coast Christian Athletic Association must sign the above
statement acknowledging that they have read and understand the above information.
