Dear Parents/Guardians,

Happy New Year! We hope you had a wonderful winter break. We are ready and excited to welcome your children back into the school tomorrow, Thursday, January 6th.

As we all know, during the winter break, the Omicron variant has been increasing substantially in Brevard and throughout the nation. If its pattern is anything like what we have seen in South Africa, it appears that it will peak in January and come down substantially by February. Fortunately, it is being reported that it is a milder virus than the Delta, but unfortunately, more transmissible. We ask for your support as we face yet another variant and look forward to returning to normalcy sometime soon.

All Odyssey schools will continue with mitigating strategies, including additional cleaning and disinfecting efforts. We will also social distance as much as possible. Masks will continue to be optional but are encouraged on buses and in crowded areas.

We will be following, to a large degree, the most current CDC recommendations for quarantining during this variant.

- Students or staff that are positive with COVID-19 should isolate for 5 days, followed by 5 days of wearing a mask (recommended) when around others to minimize the risk of infecting people they encounter.
- Students or staff who are exposed and are unvaccinated or are more than six months out from their second vaccination and are not yet boosted, the CDC now recommends quarantining for 5 days followed by mask use (recommended) for an additional 5 days.
- Students or staff who are exposed but are fully vaccinated and boosted and are showing no symptoms, the CDC is recommending the wearing of masks for 10 days (recommended).
- For all exposed, best practice would also include a test for SARS-CoV-2 at day 5 after exposure. If symptoms occur, individuals should immediately quarantine until a negative test confirms symptoms are not attributable to COVID-19.
